SUBJECT: 2021-2022 Follow-Up Survey of 2020-2021 Career and Technical Education Programs

Thank you for your continued efforts in completing the annual follow-up study administered by the Office of Career and Technical Education. Your collective efforts this spring resulted in a robust, statewide response rate of 85.3 percent of program concentrators. This represents a 0.7 percent increase compared to 2020; excellent efforts on the part of everyone in the state to submit data according to the required timeline made it possible to distribute the state reports to agencies in a timely manner.

It is now time to begin the follow-up process for the fall of 2021. Agencies that receive state reimbursement for career and technical education (CTE) programs or Carl D. Perkins funds are required to conduct the annual Career and Technical Education Follow-Up Survey. Information gathered through the Follow-Up Survey provides data that is used for state and federal reporting requirements. Through your efforts, the data gathered is a reliable source of information about students who complete CTE programs.

Our goal is to increase our survey response rate and to improve the quality of our data. Accurate data depends on accurate data on the 4483 Enrollment and Completion Collection.

Attached is a memo from the Survey Support Center, which we have contracted to assist you in conducting the survey. Also included in this mailing are copies of each of the survey forms (student, proxy, and mail) as well as two manuals. The *Follow-Up Survey of 2021 CTE Concentrators – Protocol Manual* is provided to assist district personnel in proper procedures for collecting the survey data. The *2022 Career and Technical Education Information System (CTEIS) Follow-Up Data Submission – Instructional Guide* provides data entry and submission instructions using the CTEIS web-based system. All survey materials will also be available on the CTEIS Knowledge Base at: support.cteis.com.
